You are very special to Jesus

In Luke's Gospel chapter 15, Jesus tells the story of the Good Shepherd who lost one of his sheep. He left the rest of the flock to go off and find it and bring it back to the fold.

In Luke Chapter 24 we read that on Easter Day, two of Jesus' disciples, downhearted and despondent, had left Jerusalem and were on their way home to Emmaus. They were not anybody special – one was called Cleopas, we had not heard of him before this event or afterwards, the other was not even named, but that Easter Day, the day of Jesus' resurrection, before showing himself to his eleven closest friends, he left Jerusalem and quietly joined these two lost sheep and explained to them why he had to die and rise again. Their eyes were opened; they saw Jesus and returned to Jerusalem to join the others.

These two very ordinary, weak followers were very important to Jesus – So are You.
