By the time you read this we will be on holiday for a short break. But what is a holiday? "Holy days" were days (and there were lots of them) when the Church encouraged people to stop work and celebrate the life of a saint or some holy event. Maybe instead of just thinking about our big holidays, we ought to think of each day as a sort of holy day,.. and try to get the right balance between work and play.

According to the Bible, god created the world in six days and rested on the seventh. Jews have Saturday their day of rest as the sabbath. This was the same in the time of Jesus. On that day people were supposed to have a complete rest from doing any work.

One sabbath Jesus was walking through some cornfields. As his disciples walked with him, they began to pick the ears of corn. So the Pharisees said to Jesus, "Look it is against our law to do that on the sabbath! ".. Jesus told them "The sabbath was made for the good of human beings; human beings were not made for the sabbath". Sundays today have changed but although the majority in this country do not worship, they can come together not to work but to enjoy the day that was given to them.
